Any person that believes they were incorrectly issued a violation or that the violation cited is not applicable to their occupancy classification or believes aggrieved by any action or decision of this code may appeal to the Miami-Dade County Fire Prevention and Safety Appeals Board by filing a written notice **within 15 days** of receiving the *Notice of Violation and Order to Correct*. The appeal request must be submitted in writing to the Secretary of the Board.
